Following on from the Premier's announcement this morning, it is great to hear that we had no new cases of COVID-19 in the past 24 hours and the Greater Brisbane region three-day lockdown will conclude at 6 pm tonight.

Some restrictions remain place and we are required to continue to wear masks in several key locations and situations, and to practise social distancing at all times.
