# Are you concerned about a child's safety and wellbeing?



## Report to Child Safety

If you have formed a reasonable suspicion that a child has suffered, is suffering, or is at unacceptable risk of suffering, significant harm caused by physical or sexual abuse, and there is not a parent willing and able to protect the child from harm, call Child Safety.

## Refer to Family and Child Connect

If you are concerned about a child, but you do not believe your concern meets the threshold for reporting to Child Safety, refer the child's family to Family and Child Connect. The family must give their consent to be referred for help.
